He has asked what is the cost, etc? Prairie was never charged. The belief is it's free if you also buy the product from them as well. This item will be tabled until October meeting.

The Cedar Rapids Police Department has asked Jefferson to move up the time of the Homecoming Parade to 4pm to avoid rush hour traffic. The Booster Club will again have an entry with Mark driving the gator and Lisa Stodola and Marc VanBuren handing out candy.
